Experiencing the

Roger D. Best

Back many years ago when we were expecting our third child, my wife had gone three weeks past the due date given her by the doctor. At about eight o'clock in the morning she began to have labor or birth pains, and we rushed her to the hospital. Those pains or birth pangs continued throughout the day and finally, at nine minutes to twelve on a New Year's eve, our third son was born. You see, the pains all day were not the birth but merely a sign that the time of the birth was near.

As the events of the end times begin to unfold, Jesus states what will be taking place in His Olivet Discourse. He tells us there will an abundance of false Christs, there will be an increase in wars, and there will be famines and earthquakes. He then says in Matthew 24:8, "But all these things are merely the beginning of birth pangs." In light of this there are two important questions that ought to be considered: Are we now experiencing the beginning of birth pangs? And if not how will we know when we are?

Both questions can be answered by comparing what Jesus said in Revelation 6 with what He said in Matthew 24. These passages describe the events preceeding the Rapture; God's wrath immediately follows with the beginning of the day of the Lord. Back in Daniel 9:27 God tells us that the seventieth week (commonly called the tribulation) will begin with the signing of a "covenant with the many." It is clear that a world leader will sign or strengthen a covenant between the nations and Israel guaranteeing peace to Israel. Daniel tells us that in the middle of the week that covenant will be violated; Jesus



confirms it in Matthew 24:15, "Therefore when you see the Abomination of Desolation which was Spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place . . ." And Paul explains it in 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4, "Let no one in any way deceive you, for it (the day of the Lord) will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself above every socalled god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God." With this in mind, Revelation 6 and Matthew 24 tell us what will take place, after the covenant is signed, during the first half of the seven year period.

Revelation chapter 6 begins with the opening of the first seal or, as it is commonly referred to, the first of the four horsemen of the apocalypse. It is important to understand that the seals of a book or scroll are on the outside

Birth pangs are a sign that a birth is near not the event of a birth itself. and give the requirements and conditions that must be met in order to open the book. As we look at the passage you will also notice that the opening of a seal results in common or ordinary occurrences

such as false christs, wars, and famines; there is nothing supernatural about them. In other words this is not the wrath of God but only the beginning of birth pangs. Revelation 6:1-2 describe the first seal as a rider on "a white horse, and he who sat on

it had a bow; and a crown was given to him; and he went out conquering, and to conquer." Now without help we can only speculate as to the meaning of this verse; however, as we compare what Jesus said in Matthew 24:5 we gain significant insight. "For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will mislead many." So we conclude that the first rider represents false Christs. As the seventieth week begins we see a great increase in those who claim to be the Christ.

The details of the second rider are given in Revelation 6:3-4 where we read that "a red horse went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that men should slay one another; and a great sword was given to him." Now that sounds like wars, but let's confirm it with what Jesus says in Matthew 24:6. "And you will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars; see that you are not frightened, for those things must take place, but that is not yet the end." This rider represents the conflict, wars, and rumors of wars that will spread throughout the world during the first half of the seventieth week.

Verses 5-6 tell us about the third rider. "And I looked, and behold, a black horse; and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. And I heard as it were a voice in the center of the four living creatures saying, 'A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine." Since a denarius was a day's wage it seems that there will be food shortages. Matthew 24:7 comparatively says, "And in various places there will be famines and

earthquakes." Once again, as we compare Scripture with Scripture, we find the explanation of the horseman.

Therefore, the Word of God, in two parallel passages clearly portrays the first half of the seventieth week as a time of false Christs, wars, and famines. Then in Matthew 24:8 Jesus tells us that "All these things are merely the beginning of birth pangs." Remember that birth pangs are a sign that a birth is near not the event of a birth itself. Once these signs take place, the event of Christ's second coming occurs when Jesus cuts the great tribulation short (Matthew 24:21-22), the great cosmic disturbances happen, and Jesus comes to take us to be with Him (what we commonly call the Rapture). Then immediately following Rapture, the day of the Lord's wrath begins.

To answer our two questions no, we are not yet experiencing the birth pangs, but when a world leader signs a covenant of protection with Israel we will know that the seventieth week has begun and that the birth pangs will follow shortly. What we are seeing today are the precursors that are leading up to crucial events that are yet before us. Therefore, keep your eye on Israel; she is back in her land, and she does control Jerusalem. One of these days a desperate Israel that longs for peace will sign the covenant, and the world will begin to experience the birth pangs. Let us heed the warning of the apostle Paul, "So then let us not sleep as others do, but let us be alert and sober" (1 Thessalonians 5:6).
